ASSITEJ Serbia pays special attention to the issue of young authors and artists, examines the degree of their involvement and the way in which they think about the need and effect of Theatre for Children and Youth now and in future. By organizing educational programs, ASSITEJ Serbia offers knowledge that is not covered or is not present in regular programs in formal education.

Three-day conference program refers to the specific features and trends in theatrical practice for children and young people, place of this field in cultural policies and provides operational knowledge of the project framework (LFA). Lecturers, panelists and workshop organizers are reputable professionals: Svetlana Jovičić, Anja Suša, Lola Joksimović and Predrag Cvetičanin. The venue is the Cultural Centre "Vuk Karadžić" in Belgrade and the conference will be held within the framework of 9th Festival "Pozorište Zvezdarište".

Conference is to bring together 20 participants, students of final year of cultural management and theatrical productions and/or young professionals who are at the beginning of professional engagement, (5 from Belgrade, 5 from other parts of Serbia and 10 from countries in the region), in order to facilitate networking among young creative forces from the region and

create a better climate for future partnerships in common projects of cultural and education programs for children and youth with theatre arts in its centre. To participate in the conference it is necessary to fill the application form which is attached, and send it by 20 March 2011, to the address assitejsrbija@gmail.com

Applicants should write a brief review and attach it to registration form which will be a personal view of the current situation in theatrical culture for children and youth in the environment they come from, to pinpoint a specific problem in this area in their community which should be dealt with in order to make some improvement, positive changes, and / or present the initial idea, the proposal as a basis for building the project which could affect the change.

The program is free and participants - the guests will be provided with accommodation and meals and free tickets for the festival performances. Costs of the travel to Belgrade are paid by the participants. We hope you will find this call interesting and challenging to answer noting that the number of participants is limited. Working language will be english.

With the conference "*Current theater culture for children and young people and projects for a better perspective of youth in the region*" ASSITEJ Serbia makes its contribution to marking the 50th anniversary of the Department of Management and theater productions, radio and Culture of the Faculty of Dramatic Arts in Belgrade in 2011.

Program promotes the practice of sharing knowledge, points to the importance of networking and ideas of ASSITEJ Serbia.
